Privacy Policy

Federal law requires us to tell you how we collect, use, share, and protect your personal information. Federal law also limits how we can use your personal information. We reserve the right to change this Privacy Policy from time to time. We will notify you about significant changes in the way we treat personal information by placing a prominent notice on our site, and by updating the Privacy Policy on this page. Your continued use of our products and services after such modifications will constitute your: (a) acknowledgment of the modified Privacy Policy; and (b) your agreement to abide and be bound by the modified Privacy Policy.

What We Collect and How We Collect It.

We collect two basic types of information:

Personal Information

This refers to information that lets us know the specifics of who you are. Personal Information is your personally identifiable information, including first and last name linked together with your profile image. To the extent we associate non-personal information with Personal Information, we treat the combination as Personal Information. When you engage in certain activities, such as downloading or purchasing a product or service, live streaming, submitting content, and/or sending us feedback, we may ask you to provide Personal Information, and we also may collect Personal Information as you navigate our websites.

Anonymous information

This is information that does not by itself identify you individually, does not permit a direct association with you. Anonymous Information may include one or more types of other information described in the prior paragraph; provided, however, it is not linked with your name or address, and when combined with other Anonymous Information does not provide sufficient information for a third party to identify you. We gather certain information about you based upon the products and services you use and the sites that directed you to us. We may compile and analyze this anonymous information on both a single user and an aggregated basis. Non-personal Information may include information derived from Personal Information that has been

de-personalized by removing unique identifiers and/or combining it with information about other users to form aggregated data.

How We Collect and Use Information

Personal Information

We do not collect any Personal Information about you unless you voluntarily provide it to us. However, you may be required to provide certain Personal Information to us when you use certain of our products or services. These services may include: (a) registering for an account; (b) recording yourself while live streaming; (c) entering a sweepstakes or contest sponsored by us or one of our partners; (d) signing up for special offers from selected third parties; (e) sending us an email message; (f) submitting a form or transmitting other information by telephone or letter

Permitted Uses of Personal Information

We may use Personal Information to deliver information to you and to contact you regarding administrative notices. Finally, we may use your Personal Information to resolve disputes, troubleshoot problems and enforce our agreements with you, including our Terms of Use and this Privacy Policy.

Anonymous Information

We, as well as our third party advertising partners, may collect certain Anonymous Information. For example, we may use your IP address to diagnose problems with our servers, software, to administer our products and services and to gather demographic information. Our third party advertising partners may also provide us with reports that will tell us anonymous information and statistics about you and our other users.

Cookies, Beacons and Log Files.

Cookies

Depending on how you use our products and services, we will store cookies on your computer in order to collect certain aggregate data about our users and to customize certain aspects of your specific user experience. A cookie is a small data text file which is stored on your computer that uniquely identifies your browser. Cookies may also include more personalized information, such as your IP address, browser type, the server your computer is logged onto, the area code and zip code associated with your server, and your first name to welcome you back to our website. We may use cookies to perform tasks such as: monitoring aggregate site usage metrics, storing and remembering your passwords (if you allow us to do so), storing account and advertising preferences that you have set, and personalizing the products and services we make available to you. However, we do not use cookies to track your browsing behaviors. We may also use an outside advertising partner to display advertisements on our products and services. These advertisers will place a separate cookie on your computer. We will not provide any third-party advertising partners with any of your Personal Information or information about your purchases. We and our third party advertisers will collect and use Anonymous Information about you. Most browsers are initially set up to accept cookies, but you can reset your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, some aspects of the products and services may not function properly if you elect to disable cookies.

When and How We Release Information

Law Enforcement

Occasionally, we may be required by law enforcement or judicial authorities to provide Personal Information to the appropriate governmental authorities. In such cases, we will disclose Personal Information upon receipt of a court order, subpoena, or to cooperate with a law enforcement investigation. We fully cooperate with law enforcement agencies in identifying those who use our services for illegal activities. We reserve the right to report to law enforcement agencies any activities that we in good faith believe to be unlawful.

Anonymous Information.

We may also provide third party advertisers with Anonymous Information about our customers' sales, traffic patterns, and related product and service information, but these statistics do not include any Personal Information.

Upon Sale of Our Company

If our company or substantially all of its assets is sold, goes out of business, or enters bankruptcy, user information would be one of the assets that may be transferred or acquired by a third party. You acknowledge that any acquirer of our business may continue to use your personally identifying and non-personally identifying information as set forth in this Privacy Policy.

How to Update and Correct Your Information

Updating Your Information

We believe you should have the ability to access and edit the Personal Information that you have provided to us. You may change any of your Personal Information in your account at any time by logging into your account. We encourage you to promptly update your Personal Information if it changes. Your Controls Over How we Collect and Use Your Information

Choices

Security Precautions

Security

The security, integrity and confidentiality of your information are extremely important to us. We have implemented technical, administrative and physical security measures that are designed to protect user information from unauthorized access, disclosure, use and modification. From time to time, we review our security procedures to consider appropriate new technology and methods. Please be aware though that, despite our best efforts, no security measures are perfect or impenetrable. We will retain your Personal Information for the length of time needed to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by law.

Access Limits

We limit access to Personal Information to specific employees, contractors and agents who have a reasonable need to access your information. For example, we may provide members of our technical support team with limited access to your account in order to allow them to troubleshoot problems you may be having. Wherever your Personal Information is transferred, stored or processed by us, we will take reasonable steps to safeguard the privacy of your Personal Information. Additionally, when using or disclosing Personal Information transferred from the European Union, we abide by the Safe Harbor Principles as set forth by the U.S. Department of Commerce, use standard contract clauses approved by the European Commission, adopt other means under European Union law for ensuring adequate safeguards, or obtain your consent. We also apply the substantive requirements of the Safe Harbor Principles when transferring Personal Information from Australia. Security Breaches Possible
